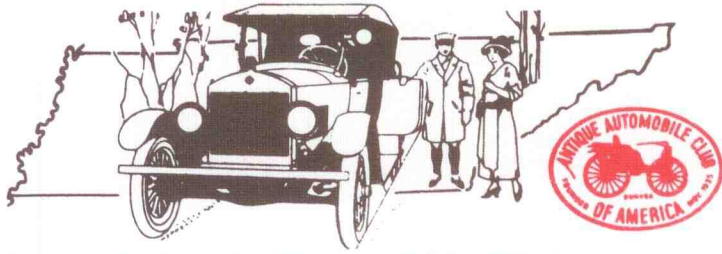

We have a new event coming up. On April 13, 2012 there will be a tour to Granville. This will be a two day event. On Friday evening at 7:30 p.m. there will be a "Dinner & Play" in Granville. The play will be "Romances of Mayberry". Our own Randall Clemons will be in the play. He will be playing Otis. Now for the details. We will meet at the Garage at 5:00 p.m. on Friday and caravan to Granville. The "Dinner & Play" will start at 7:30 p.m. Overnight arrangements have been made. There are several Bed & Breakfasts available. The cost for the dinner, play and Bed & Breakfast will be \$125.00 per couple. On Saturday there will be a tour of the Museum, Homestead, Pioneer Village, Antique Car Museum and the 50's Service Station. For couples interested in attending the "Dinner & Play" only, the cost is \$40.00 plus tax. If you are attending as a single, the "Dinner & Play" is \$20.00 plus tax, and if you are interested in staying overnight, the entire cost would be \$100.00. Again, the entire cost for a couple is \$125.00 and the cost for the entire event for a single is \$100.00.
